Ms Linda Low is the Head of Strategy Planning at the Department of Planning and Economy, Abu Dhabi, UAE.

Ms Low's areas of specialization include public sector economics and public policy, public enterprises and privatization, social security, health economics, international trade and regionalism, international political economy and development economics.

In Singapore, she is a Senior Fellow at the Institute of Southeast Asian Studies (ISEAS). She is a consultant to the Singapore Government, providing advice to the Ministry of Trade and Industry on the EU-Singapore Free Trade Area, the Ministry of Community Development and Sports, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Manpower, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Port of Singapore Authority, National University of Singapore, Singapore Tourism Board, Trade Development Board, Economic Development Board and several other government boards and agencies.
